Pursuant to the authority given to this Court through Washington State Supreme Court Orders 25700-B-602 through B-646 (and any superseding or modified orders) and the authority granted to the Presiding Judge of Snohomish County Superior Court pursuant to GR 29, this Second Addendum and Supplement to Emergency Order #14 shall be in effect immediately.


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Paragraph 3(c) is clarified to indicate any motion for a remote appearance for a SAPO, VAPO, or ERPO must be filed on the motions calendar for the Presiding Judge no later than three days prior to the scheduled hearings, but no notice is required to be provided to the adverse party for this ex-parte motion. A motion form can be found at <https://www.snohomishcountywa.gov/5523/Snohomish-County-Superior-Court-Forms> entitled "Motion for Remote Appearance- Protection Order Hearing." The party making the request shall send an email to the law clerk for the Presiding Judge including their phone number and email so they can be notified if the request to appear remotely has been granted.

2. If the request to appear remotely is granted, and on the day set for the hearing the party that was granted permission to appear remotely cannot appear remotely, they shall notify the Court by sending an email to the law clerk for the Presiding Judge, by sending an email to [SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org](mailto:SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org), and by calling 425-388-3421.
3. Pursuant to paragraph 45A, any party requesting to appear remotely for a hearing on a DVPO or AHO shall make such request using the form entitled “Motion for Remote Appearance- Protection Order Hearing” located at <https://www.snohomishcountywa.gov/5523/Snohomish-County-Superior-Court-Forms> by sending such a request to [SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org](mailto:SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org) or by dropping off a copy in the ex-parte basket. The party making the request to appear remotely shall also complete the form required, which includes contact information, so the Court can notify the party that their request for a remote appearance is granted or denied.
4. If the motion to appear remotely is granted, and on the day set for the hearing, that party cannot appear remotely, they shall be required to notify the Court by calling 425-388-3421 and by sending an email to [SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org](mailto:SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org).

All provisions of Emergency Order #14 and the First Amendment to Emergency Order #14 which are not superseded by this Second Addendum and Supplement to Emergency Order #14 shall remain in full force and effect.
