

## Jordan Creek Bridge 214 Replacement Planned for 2024

Snohomish County Public Works is currently considering two construction options for the Jordan Creek Bridge Replacement Project. The bridge is scheduled to be replaced in the spring/summer of 2024.

### Construction Options

During construction, options to accommodate motorists may include:

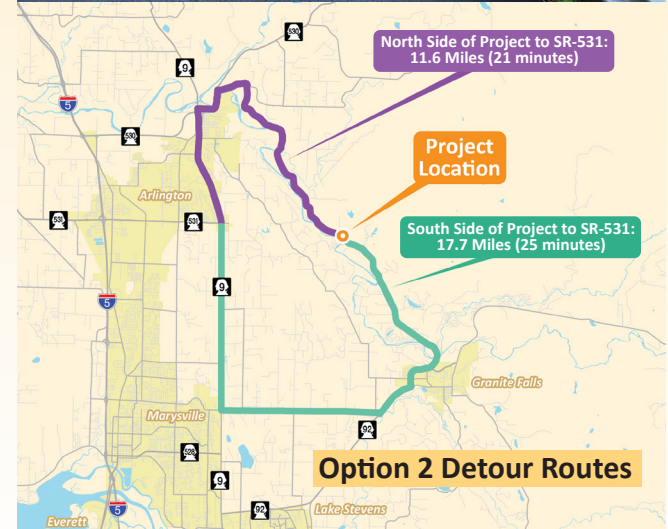
- Option 1: a phased approach with a temporary bypass bridge; project estimated to take 16 months; increases costs by \$450,000.
- Option 2: a detour route with a 4- to 6-week full bridge closure in the summer; project anticipated to take 8 months.
