Weekly Update for SMART Case #21-01

Smart Incident 21-01

SNOHOMISH, Wash. – Detectives with the Snohomish County Multiple Agency Response Team (SMART) continue to investigate the use of force incident that occurred on September 27 in a parking lot of Clearview Plaza (17500 block of SR-9). SMART detectives have served multiple search warrants, including on the suspect's vehicle and for medical records pertaining to this incident. Detectives are working with the Washington State Patrol Crime Lab to analyze the collected evidence.

The suspect, a 39-year-old man, remains hospitalized in stable condition at Harborview Medical Center. He is expected to be released and booked into the King County Jail.

The investigation is being conducted by the [Snohomish County Multiple Agency Response Team \(SMART\)](#). SMART is a team of investigators, evidence technicians, records specialist, and public information officers from various Snohomish County law enforcement agencies and Washington State Patrol, who respond to, and investigate, police use of force incidents. There are civilian community members that also serve on the SMART team per the Law Enforcement Training and Community Safety

Act (LETSCA). When the SMART investigation is complete, results will be forwarded to the Snohomish County Prosecutor's Office for review.
