Steps to achieve employment - Employment is your top priority!

- *A Job Foundation report will be completed during your second to last year of transition.*
- *During your final year we will focus on job development and employment.*

Complete the following no later than August 31st

1. Complete application packet for Job Foundation; it can be found here; link here or find the application at <https://www.snohomishcountywa.gov/5932/Job-Foundation>

2. Must choose an Employment Provider to work with; [Click Here](#) to view Employment Provider options
3. Must be eligible with Developmental Disabilities Administration ([DDA](#)): can confirm eligibility by calling 425-740-6400
4. Apply for Social Security Benefits ([SSI/Medicaid](#)) – You may apply online at www.ssa.gov or call 1-800-772-1213 or have other means of paying for long term support
5. Apply for Division of Vocational Rehabilitation ([DVR](#)) Everett 425-339-4880, Lynnwood 425-977-6600 or Smokey Pt. 360-651-6120
6. Have reliable transportation to get to and from work site or be committed to apply for services
7. Person Centered Planning ([PCP](#)) is available to help you look at holistic planning to reach your employment goals

September 2022 – June 2023

1. Meet with your team to establish and develop your employment plan and goals by discussing your:
 - Job Foundation Report
 - Long term support needs and funding options
 - Community based employment that focuses on your skills and interests
2. Meet with a Benefits Planner ([BP](#)) to understand how wages may affect your state and federal benefits
