**Administrative Order 22 – 04**

**Snohomish County District Court  
Order-Setting Bail in Criminal Matters**

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Presiding Judge of the Snohomish County District Court in GR 29, this Order is effective March 29, 2022, and shall remain in effect until September 1, 2022 unless renewed, modified, or rescinded by the Snohomish County District Court Presiding Judge.

**Order**

(a) A person arrested for a misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor offense shall be subject to the following bail schedule:

(1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) below, bail for a person arrested for a misdemeanor offense shall be \$500 and bail for a person arrested for a gross misdemeanor offense shall be \$1,000.

(2) Domestic Violence: A person arrested pursuant to RCW 10.31.100(2)(a) – (d) shall be held in custody until release by a judicial officer on bail, personal recognizance, or court order.

(3) Driving Under the Influence or Physical Control: Bail for a person arrested for a violation of RCW 46.61.502 or RCW 46.61.504, and where RCW 10.31.100(16)(a) is not applicable, shall be \$2,500.

(4) Nothing in this order shall limit the authority of a Judicial Officer to deviate from the bail schedule.

(b) A person arrested for a felony offense shall be held in-custody until they have posted bail according to a bail schedule established by the Superior Court or appeared before a Judicial Officer. Nothing in this order shall limit the authority of a Judicial Officer to deviate from the bail schedule.

(c) This Administrative Order is effective March 29, 2022 and supersedes SCLCrRLJ 3.2. This Order shall remain in effect until September 1, 2022, when new local rules become effective unless renewed, modified, or rescinded by the Snohomish County District Court Presiding Judge.
