SMART Investigates Officer Involved Shooting in Edmonds

SMART Case #22-04

EDMONDS, Wash. – Detectives with the Snohomish County Multiple Agency Response Team (SMART) are investigating an officer involved shooting that occurred at approximately 12 p.m. at a motel in the 22100 block of Highway 99.

Edmonds Police Department officers were on scene investigating a domestic violence incident involving a male suspect in his 40s and an adult woman. Officers developed probable cause to arrest the suspect.

The suspect advanced at officers while armed with a knife. One officer deployed his taser. The suspect continued to advance, and shots were fired by another officer.

Officers immediately rendered aid to the man, and medics transported him to Harborview Medical Center where he later succumbed to his injuries.

The Snohomish County Medical Examiner will release the identity of the decedent, as well as determine cause and manner of death.

The investigation is being conducted by the [Snohomish County Multiple Agency Response Team \(SMART\)](#). SMART is a team of investigators, evidence technicians, records specialist, and public information officers from various Snohomish County law enforcement agencies and Washington State Patrol, who respond to, and investigate, police use of force incidents. There are civilian community members that also serve on the SMART team per the Law Enforcement Training and Community Safety Act (LETSCA). When the SMART investigation is complete, results will be forwarded to the Snohomish County Prosecutor's Office for review.
