**C**ampsites, cabins, picnic shelters\*, and the amphitheater can be reserved (9 months to 72 hrs prior to arrival) online at [www.SnoCoParks.org](http://www.SnoCoParks.org) or through the Call Center at 425-388-6600.

## Rules, Regs, & Policies

**O**kay, every park has them, so let's get it over with. To maximize your enjoyment, take a few moments to review some important rules.

### Day-use

- Park hours are 7 AM—Dusk
- Alcoholic beverages, fireworks, and discharging of firearms are strictly prohibited
- No hibachis and/or barbeques on table tops
- **All vehicles must display a valid parking permit**

### Pets:

- Must be kept on an 8' leash, and under control at all times.
- Pets must be attended at all times
- Remember to scoop! Remove all your dog's feces. The shoe you save may be your own

### Motor Vehicles:

- Speed limit is 10 mph unless otherwise posted
- Bicycles, scooters, and skateboards are allowed on the roadway and must travel in the same direction as motor vehicles

### Noise:

- For the enjoyment of all park visitors, loud speakers, stereo systems, and vuvuzelas are prohibited
- Campground quiet hours are 10 PM— 8 AM

### Camping:

- All campsites, cabins, shelter, and amphitheater can be reserved at [SnoCoParks.org](http://SnoCoParks.org). Unreserved sites can be rented on a walk-in basis
- Walk-in payments are made by completing a fee envelop and dropping in the fee box located at the campground bulletin board (kiosk). Be sure to include Transaction Fee for each site
- If a motor home or truck/camper setup needs to temporarily leave the site, please make arrangements with the ranger to secure the site.
- Firewood sales are available during daylight hrs
- Campground stays are limited to no more than 14 days in a 30 day period

# Flowing Lake County Park

*at Leckie's Beach*



Snohomish County's Flowing Lake Park at Leckie's Beach provides cabin, tent and RV camping in a beautiful 40+ acre park. Come for the day or stay for the night!

## Campsites



Choose between Standard (non-utility), Walk-in (non-utility), Utility (water & power), or ADA Utility, Privacy abounds and most sites accommodate up to 40' RVs. All include a picnic table, & fire ring or BBQ grill. Make your reservation at [www.SnoCoParks.org](http://www.SnoCoParks.org). Weekend reservations require a Friday & Saturday night stay. Note: The campground is closed during the winter months Dump station services are not available at the park.

## Cabins



Open year-round, our warm & cozy cabins offer light, heat, electricity, & security. Bring your sleeping bags or linen for the bunks and/or futons that sleep 5. Outside, you'll find a water faucet, picnic table, and fire ring (for toasting and roasting). Cabins 3 & 4 are pet friendly! By reservation only—sorry, no drop-in camping.



## Day-Use



Day-use amenities include a designated swim area, boat launch, fishing dock, playground, volleyball court, walking trails, restroom (w/outdoor shower), picnic tables, and BBQ grills. Hours are 7am-Dusk. Please note, there are no life-guards on duty. Flowing Lake is a Fee-Use park—display your day-use permit (purchased at the entrance) at all times. Annual Passes can be purchased at [www.snocoparks.org](http://www.snocoparks.org), through the Call Center at 425-388-6600, or from a Ranger.

## Driving Directions:

**From I-5** take Exit 194 (US-2) east to mile 10. From left-turn lane, take a left onto 100th St SE (Westwick Rd.) When road curves sharply to the left it becomes 171st Ave SE. Stay on 171st to 48th St SE. Turn right onto 48th and follow to the end of the road.

**From SR-522** Take US-2 west approximately 1/2 mile and turn right onto Robinhood Ln. At end of that road turn left onto Trombley Rd. Follow Trombley to 167 Ave SE and turn right. Follow 167th to the end and turn right onto Westwick Rd. Westwick becomes 171st Ave SE which you will follow to 48th St SE. Turn right onto 48th St. Park is at the end of road.
