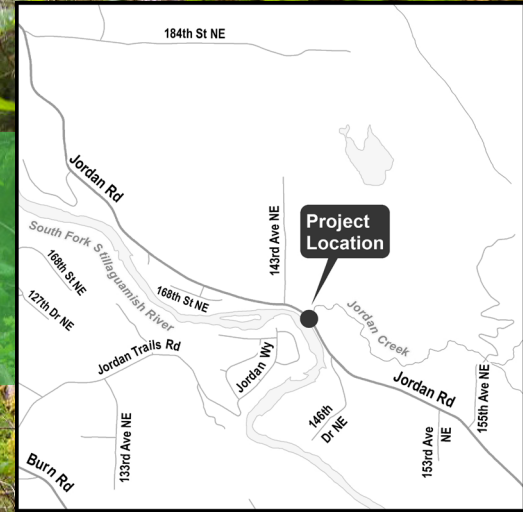


Notice of Land Disturbing Activity (LDA) Permit Application Jordan Creek Bridge 214 Replacement



Description:

This is a revised notice of LDA Permit Application due to major design changes. Snohomish County Public Works proposes to replace Jordan Creek Bridge #214 at its crossing of Jordan Creek on Jordan Road. The existing bridge is a two-lane 21-foot wide and approximately 107-foot long timber trestle bridge supported by creosote-treated timber piles with a timber deck. The bridge is functionally obsolete and structurally deficient and is currently load limited and reduced to one 16-foot lane. The new single span girder bridge will be 120 feet long and have two 11-foot travel lanes and 6-foot shoulders. Vehicular traffic will be detoured around the site during construction. A new stormwater conveyance system and infiltration pond is proposed to meet the stormwater requirements of flow control and water quality. New right-of-way

acquisitions are required for the proposed roadway and stormwater facility improvements, as well as onsite compensatory mitigation for unavoidable impacts to critical areas buffers. The project is scheduled for construction in summer of 2024.

Location:

The proposed bridge is located on Jordan Road between 143rd Ave NE and the 155th Ave NE, southeast of the City of Arlington, in Section 2, Township 31 North, Range 6 East.

Area to be cleared or grubbed: 2.4 acres

Cut quantity: 5,500 cu. yds.; Fill quantity: 2,000 cu. yds.
